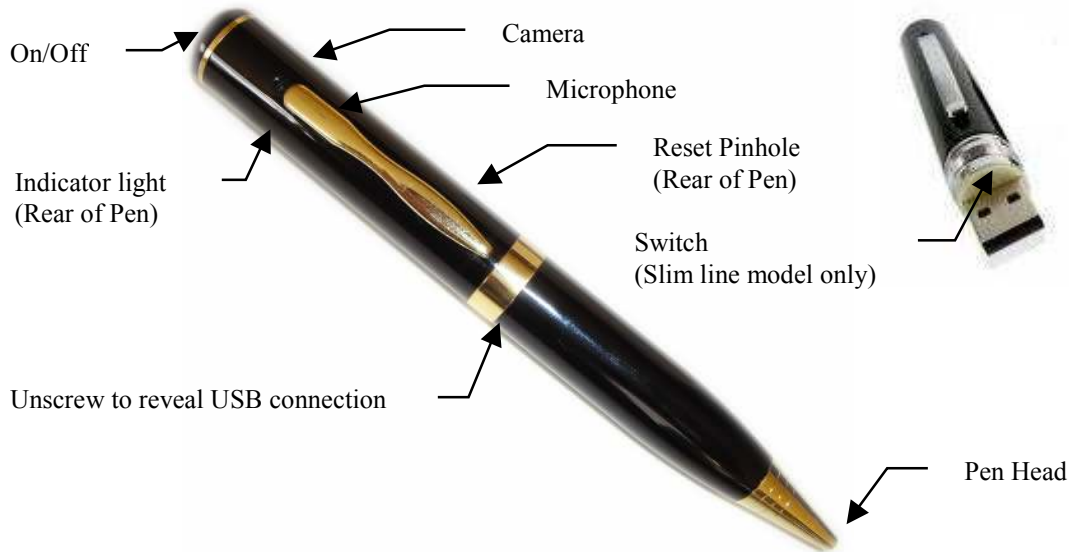

1) Introduction (All Models)

The first DVR pen in the world that is both a camera and a recorder in the shape of a pen that also works as a pen.

Durable construction and smooth writing with standard refill.

Simply plug the DVR into a standard USB port to watch the recorded video. No additional drivers or external power source required.

2) Instructions

- a) Push the top button to switch on and start recording (Light illuminates Yellow while starting up, then turns to Blue when recording has started)
Keep the pen at least 50cm from the recording subject.
- b) Push the top button again to stop recording (Light changes from Blue to Yellow again to signify that recording has stopped)
- c) If the DVR is left for 60 seconds without recording it will automatically switch off.
- d) You can start and stop recording at any time while there is sufficient memory remaining.
- e) To switch off, push and hold the top button for 2-3 seconds, (Yellow light should turn off to confirm that the DVR is switched off)
- f) When connecting to a USB for the first time, the PC will detect the DVR and install the appropriate drivers.

3) Charging

- a) Connect the DVR to a PC USB port to charge, or use the supplied travel adaptor.

4) Reset

- a) Using a non metallic tool, insert into the pinhole on the back of the DVR pen to press the reset button. (Do not force, gentle pressure should be sufficient)

5) Photo/Video Mode Setting (Slim Line model only)

Mode setting switch viewed with USB connector pointing up, and should only be changed when DVR is off.

- a) Slide the mode switch to the Left for Photo Mode.

Switch the DVR on (Lamp Turns Blue to indicate ready), then press the top button briefly to take a single image (Lamp flashes once Yellow to indicate image has been taken)

- b) Slide the mode switch to the right for Video Mode

Switch the DVR on (Lamp Turns Blue to indicate that recording has commenced). Pressing the top button briefly stops recording. (Lamp turns Yellow to indicate recording has stopped)

6) Time and Date setting

The DVR pen can display time and date stamp on the images recorded with the DVR in the format:

Year-Month-Day Hour: Minute: Second

This can be set up as follows:

- a) Open the TXT file located in the /PEN/ folder on the DVR**
- b) Edit the date and time to the current date and time, using the format
Year-Month-Day Hour: Minute: Second**
- c) Save the updated file in the root directory of the DVR pen (Not in /PEN/ folder)**
- d) Remove the pen from the USB and switch off (If the DVR remains on) then on again**
- e) The date and time are now set, and the new file will have been deleted**
